

## RSG requirements throughout Australia

STATE/TERRITORY	REQUIREMENT
<p>QUEENSLAND  <a href="http://www.olgr.qld.gov.au/">http://www.olgr.qld.gov.au/</a></p>	<p>From 1 October 2010, all people who carry out gaming duties or gaming tasks within a licensed club or licensed hotel must complete the approved OLGR RSG course, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• eligible licensee</li> <li>• gaming nominee</li> <li>• holder of a gaming employee licence performing gaming duties</li> <li>• any person performing gaming tasks.</li> </ul> <p>An eligible licensee is an individual licensee who is ordinarily present on the licensed premises when the premises is open for the conduct of gaming.</p> <p>An OLGR approved <b>RSG bridging</b> course is available for anyone who holds a national RSG certificate or other state territory RSG certificate with national competency SITHGAM006A. You can upgrade to the OLGR RSG course certificate by completing the OLGR RSG Bridging Course. You are required to submit your other RSG certificate to CFT QLD to be authorised prior to printing your certificate.</p>

They are also required to undertake an approved refresher course within three years following completion of an approved course.</p> <p>CFT is approved to deliver this training</p>
